The Front Porch Library is a neighborhood children's lending library on the porch of a family home in Seminole Manor. Every Sunday the library is open for books, projects, snacks, games and all around fun.

On Sundays there is a project or program focused on art, science, drama, music, or community service. High school, and neighborhood volunteers are always there to help.

The library has a collection of over 3,000 books that can be

checked out just by getting a library card.

The library is open to kids of all ages. Children under the age of five (5) must be with a parent or adult. Kids five and older can come to the library on their own after getting a library card.
